
Dr. Arlin French Receives Good Samaritan Award

Arlin French, D.O., is an ophthalmologist, a member of the DHM medical staff, and now he is a good Samaritan, according to the Lake Orion Police

Department. Dr. French received an official "Citizen Citation" on May 28th from the Lake Orion Police department for saving a man's life who had crashed his personal watercraft on Lake Orion back in September '08. As Dr. French relays, he and his family were enjoying a day at the lake when they witnessed a man on a Seadoo hit an on-shore boat hoist at a very high

speed. The man was "face down and unresponsive" when Dr. French, along with another bystander Rick Rice, came to the immediate aid of the injured victim.

In a Citizen Citation given to Dr. French by the Lake Orion Chief of Police, Jerry L. Nash, it was stated that "The quick actions of Arlin French prevented additional injury or even death to the operator of the watercraft and provided invaluable eyewitness account that enabled the Lake Orion Police Department to accurately investigate the crash scene."
